Discussion and Possible Action on Ordinance No. 434 an ordinance ordering a Special Election to be held in the City of West Orange, Texas on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to present to the qualified voters of the City of West Orange, Texas a proposition pertaining to the reauthorization of a local sales and use tax in the City of West Orange at the rate of one-fourth of one percent to provide revenue for maintenance and repair of municipal streets; and dependent of approval of item #1 above, no more than four proposed amendments to the existing charter of the city; stating the subject matter of the proposed amendments to the city charter to be voted on at said election, stating the location of the polling place and designating the City of West Orange as one voting precinct; making certain provisions related to the manner of voting in the conduct of the elections; prescribing the form of ballot to be used; providing that this ordinance shall constitute an order for such election and that proper notice thereof shall be given

*Discusión y posible acción en la Ordenanza No. 434 una ordenanza que ordena Elecciones Especiales en la Ciudad de West Orange, Texas el 5 de mayo de 2018 para presentar a los votantes calificados de la Ciudad de West Orange, Texas una proposición perteneciente a la reautorización de un impuesto local de ventas y uso en la Ciudad de West Orange a razón de un cuarto del uno por ciento para proporcionar ingresos por mantenimiento y reparación de calles municipales; y dependiendo de la aprobación del ítem n. ° 1 anterior, no más de cuatro enmiendas propuestas a la carta existente de la ciudad; indicando el tema de las enmiendas propuestas al estatuto de la ciudad a ser votado en dicha elección, indicando la ubicación del lugar de votación y designando a la Ciudad de West Orange como un recinto de votación; hacer ciertas disposiciones relacionadas con la forma de votar en la realización de las elecciones; prescribir la forma de la boleta que se utilizará; siempre que esta ordenanza constituya una orden para tal elección y que se le dé una notificación apropiada*
