

ORDINANCE NO. 149-A

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER(S) 78 AND 149 IN THEIR ENTIRETY AND ADOPTING ORDINANCE 149-A - AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND PROMOTE THE PUBLIC WELFARE OF THE CITY OF WEST ORANGE, TEXAS, BY PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF DRAIN BOXES IN CULVERTS MORE THAN TWENTY-FOUR (24) FEET IN LENGTH; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST ORANGE, TEXAS, that

WHEREAS, Ordinance numbers 78 and 149 shall be repealed in full and replaced with the contents of the herein Ordinance Number 149-A; and shall read as follows:

WHEREAS, On all commercial and residential property within the City of West Orange, Texas where culverts are hereafter installed, more than twenty-four (24) feet in length, along street easements, there shall be installed at the expense of the owner, a drain box and cover, made of a quality durable substance and thickness, approved by the Director of Public Works, not less than three feet in length on commercial property and not less than four feet in length on residential property. Said drain boxes and covers shall be placed at regular intervals of twenty-four (24) feet or less in length; and

WHEREAS, Any person, firm or individual violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, thereof, fined a sum of money not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and not more than an amount allowed by law, based upon the severity of the violation, as deemed by the Court. Each and every day's violation shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
